SERIOUS INJURIES

For incidents resulting in death, amputation, loss of an eye, disfigurement, and/or in-patient hospitalization, immediately call 650-725-9999

WHEN TO REPORT

As soon as possible! And within the same day.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU REPORT

After you report, safety professionals will:

- Follow up and gather information
- Perform necessary analysis
- Assign corrective actions (if applicable)
- Promote learning and communications

Taking these steps will help make Stanford a safer place to work, study, and conduct research.
